I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Read's letter of the 9th instant (27731/1912), relative to the meeting of the cost during the current financial year of the patrol now being sent through the Marehan District in the North Eastern corner of the East Africa Protectorate.

My Lords observe that Mr. Secretary Harcourt would strongly deprecate postponing the erection of the new public offices to meet the cost of the Patrol, and in deference to his representations They assent to the proposal that the cost of the patrol should be met from general savings on the authorized expenditure of the Protectorate for the current financial year.
