Sir,

I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Read's letter of the 11th instant (32864/1912) and its accompanying copy of a telegram from the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate further relative to the proposed expenditure during the current financial year of a sum of £3,184, on Public Works Extraordinary in excess of the provision made under that Head of the Protectorate Estimates for 1912/13.

In reply I am to request you to inform Mr. Secretary Harcourt that My Lords now sanction the proposed expenditure, on the understanding that it will be defrayed from general savings on the Estimates for the current year, and not from balances.
