of October 30th. X

I am prepared to accept the second of The Governor's
alternative proposals with its increased payment of Rs.2 per
100 cubic feet for timber (if any) not passed through the mill;
provided that all ambiguity in respect of the agreement as now
covered by Memoranda is excluded by the insertion of a clause
expressing the following intention:
the licensee shall pay royalty at the rate of Rs.1.88
per 100 cubic feet for all milled timber and at the
rate of Rs.2 per 100 cubic feet for all the serviceable
resuable timber in the boles of any trees which having
been marked for felling by the Forest Department shall
for any reason not be passed through the mills."
