We told Mr. Morrison, in our letter of the 27th of July in ^{no. 2854} that, in accordance with the usual rule, the communication to which we were then acknowledging should have been submitted through the O.A.G. He has now deliberately ignored the rule to which we called his attention.

In any case his telegram does not enable the S. B. to form any opinion upon the ~~case~~ action of the Govt. in refusing

I think the case would be adequately
met if we told the Govt. by despatch that this
telegram has been received, & asked for a
report upon it, requesting the Govt. to
remind Mr Morrison that it is the rule
