Sir,

In reply to your despatch No. 876 of the 19th ultimo, I have the honour to refer to paragraph 6 of my despatch No. 23 of November 27th, which had probably not yet reached you, when you asked for information as to the ~~work~~ made in formulating a scheme for the drainage of Mombasa.

2. As you will see, it is not thought desirable to make any recommendations until the arrival of the ~~work~~ Sanitary Officer whose appointment has been suggested.

3. It was not found possible to prepare the contoured plan of Mombasa last year, as was anticipated by Sir Percy Girouard, owing to the other urgent demands on the staff of the Survey Department. A surveyor has however now been sent and it is hoped that all the necessary data will be available when required.
