In our letter of 25th January (1913) we asked for further details of the excess expenditure of £500. (It has been approved by Treas 35299) The £500 was made up of two instalments of £200 (October 1912) & £300 (December 1912) and was required for expenses connected with the upkeep of the laboratory & put by.

Sir,

With reference to your despatch No. 71 of the 25th of January respecting additional expenditure in the Pathological Division of the Agricultural Department in connection with the production of Serum, I have the honour to report that the total excess of £500 was applied for and sanctioned by me in two instalments viz: £300 in October and £200 in December last. In his original application the Veterinary Pathologist pointed out that it might be necessary at some later date to apply for a further supplementary allocation, and his anticipation proved to be correct.

2. The greater part of the £500 was perforce devoted to general expenses in connection with the upkeep of the Laboratory, (in order that the continuity of the work might not suffer) together with the purchase of food-stuffs, wages etc for the production of anti-rinderpest serum.
