It happened that the floverment 550 denoi loss was alongeide the Sendili manyatta and in it were 1 gomali askari and 5 armed gross, On the clare being raised my men opened fire and the Bendilf Moran assembling in some force the raiders desisted, and drew off. Beautifle the Casturu Boran were following their egitle and a running fight engued for about 10 miles. may through the raiders finding that they were haspered by the large mon of cattle abandoned half of it and tried to get away with the rest. At the end of about 10 miles my askaries from the Soma were seen approaching and the raiders than shandened all the eattle and took to flight. The askaries then returned with the sattle. Some Moran followed the raiders as far as Berkum which is about 40 to the miles from the Boma on the road to Eulal and there gave over the pursuit.

about 25 of the raiders were killed and 14 of our natives killed or wounded.

4 rifles (French) and 80 rounds of ammunition were captured.

The raiders we on foot without any transport.

This leads me to suppose that they probably came from a
base camp somewhere in our ferritory possibly florr though
this is not a conclusive deduction as owing to the present
rains they are independent of water.

I have endeavoured to warn the Broops at Bulal but the natives are very nervous now of that side of the Mistrict.
