

I have the honour to forward herewith my usual six-monthly return for the period ended December 31st 1912.

At the end of June last we had some 250 applications pending. During the period under review we have had 156 new applications registered, making a total of 446 to be dealt with.

In the same six months we have registered 181 new deeds compared with 186 for the previous six months, a further 18 have been cancelled or withdrawn making the total remaining 279 compared with 280 for the previous six months.

A glance at the detailed analysis will show that a large number of the uncompleted deeds come under the several headings:-

Pending return of draft deeds (1), Pending engraving (11), Pending return of counterpart deeds and money (28), Pending registration (82), so on a total of 124 out of the 279 have reached the final stages thus leaving 155 as the subject of further marks compared with 172 in the previous six months.

4. The two items, Pending negotiations (105), and Pending survey (27), totalling 132 leave only 33 out of the 165 pending under other heads.

5. This number 33 against 32 for the previous six months is made up of Pending selection (2), Pending plans (13), Pending return of draft deeds (8) and may be taken as normal, and calls for no remarks.

6. As I predicted very last month the large item, Pending negotiations, is likely to remain a high one for reasons absolutely beyond my control, and the figure + 100 may be looked upon as normal for some time to come, that remark applies equally to-day and the figure 105 compared with 102 for the previous six months bears out my prediction.

7. With regard to the head Pending Survey I said that we might expect further improvement but that 165+ figure was ~~8/~~ a high look upon it as normal and reasonable at the moment 27 is that it may be looked upon as satisfactory

8. I append as usual a table for a period of three years showing the position as regards the removal of applications placed under the indefinite heading, Pending negotiations, to the other more or less definite stages recorded in the analysis. This table is interesting inasmuch as it shows that new applications have been steadily coped with, in the six months under review though 186 new applications have been received 183 have been wiped off the slate, leaving the number pending negotiations at 105 compared with 102.

9. In conclusion I would say that I consider the record is again a satisfactory one the figures under all heads having become more or less normal.
