Sir,

I have the honor to report that in March last 2 head of cattle were stolen from the farm of a Mr. Clark the boundaries of which abuts on the Lusitwa Nairobi Road.

2. The tracks of the animals were followed across the road and traced to the location of Chief Amup Tainia of the Lusitwa tribe who was informed and ordered to institute a search immediately. These orders were however ignored with the result that it has been impossible to discover either the cattle, or the actual perpetrators of the crime.

3. I have already reported in previous despatches the necessity for stringent measures in dealing with thefts of stock by members of the Lusitwa tribe, and also that the circumstances attendant on the appearance of strange animals in a location could not possibly be

concealed from any of its members, existing as they do in such complete community of interest. There can be no doubt that in this particular instance the members of Arap Taminee's location, including Arap Taminee himself, are fully cognizant of the perpetrators of the theft and the whereabouts of the goods.

4. The evidence in this case, as stated by the Attorney General on 13th Feb 1910, and the circumstances justify the imposition of a pecuniary fine under the Collectors' Regulations Ordinance 1909. I have therefore ordered the location concerned to pay the sum of Rs. 375/- being five times the value of the stolen stock, and trust you will approve my course in this matter.
