Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the second paragraph of your despatch No. 370 of 15th ultimo and to transmit herewith a plan of the Township of Eldoret.

2. You will observe that due care and forethought have been exercised in separating the various sections of the Township with a view to conforming in so far as possible or convenient to the various purposes for which they have been set apart, and in particular that the Indian Quarter, Section IX and X and not X and XI as shown on the plan, is sufficiently removed from that allotted to Europeans to safeguard the future welfare of the township; and ensure the adoption of more systematic methods than those which have characterised the laying out of certain townships in the past.

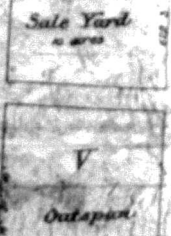
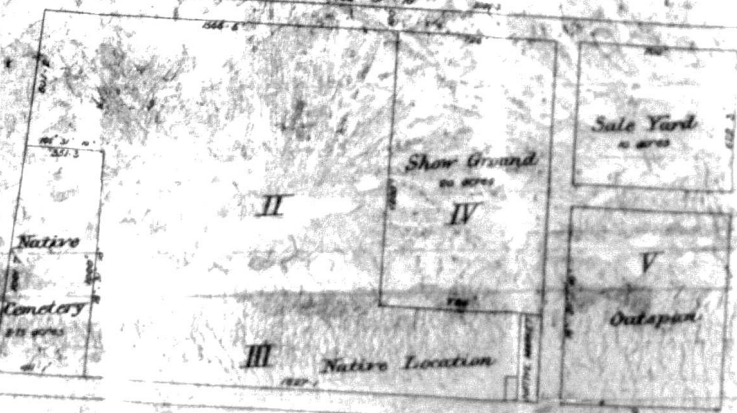
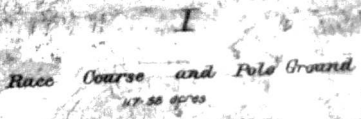

2. So far as I can judge, much care and forethought have been devoted to the laying out of this township on proper lines. It is not stated in your despatch that the medical and sanitary authorities have been consulted; <sup>but</sup> and I ~~am~~ <sup>am</sup> of opinion that all such matters should come before the Chief Sanitary Officer in the ordinary course, <sup>in that</sup>
