With reference to my despatch No. 526 of the 9th of July, I have the honour to inform you that the General Manager, Uganda Railway, has represented to me the difficulty of providing for the medical examination in this Protectorate of officers of the Lake Kioga steamers, owing to the fact that, as a rule, they make no break in their journey to the coast on the Uganda Railway, and remain at Kisumu for a few hours only, at night, on their arrival from Uganda.
