Re JUBALAND

We have asked the Crown Agents for the Colonies, if they would telegraph, at our expense, to the Land Office at Nairobi, to find out what is the nominal rent that is charged by the Government of the Protectorate on land concessions.

To make it plainer, Mr. Argyropoulos has 6,000 acres of land on the Juba, on the usual Government lease of 99 years, and he informs me that, when the land is producing, he will be charged a nominal rental for the said land.

It is very urgent that I should know what this nominal rent is.

The Crown Agents, in reply to our enquiry, suggest that we should communicate with the Colonial Office on this matter, or direct with the Government of the Protectorate at Nairobi.

As I am not known to the Governor at Nairobi, it is probable that, if I telegraphed direct, I should not get a reply, and I should feel exceedingly obliged if you could assist me in this matter.
