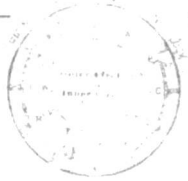

No. 164. Your telegram of July ~~18th~~ ^{16th} consider that two additional executive engineers, three assistant engineers and accountant should be pensionable. Further recommend that one executive engineer and two assistant engineers shown on sanctioned estimates as unpensionable could be made pensionable. Reynolds then would become pensionable. He is recommended for promotion to executive engineer. Remaining vacancy lies between Macnaghten and Steadman but prefer to make no recommendation pending return of Director of Public Works. Then there will be 4 vacancies for assistant engineers, grade for two of which Linnell and Hamp are recommended. No local candidates available for remaining 2 vacancies. Hoey recommended as accountant. Hewitt timekeeper recommended as sub-storekeeper. Foremen Williams Calder and Aldridge recommended for promotion to overseer grade. Vacancies timekeeper and foremen could be filled locally. Two clerks and one draughtsman required from home.
