AGRICULTURAL LAND

Submits further information in support of his recommendations for the alienation of agricultural land. Encloses memo by Committee apptd to draw up Schedules prescribing the development conditions to attach to the various classes of rural lands. Requests early decision.

Letter for Sir J. Anderson

We have now, in the enclosure to the despatch, got definite views as to the permanent development conditions; but they relate only to the period of the three years occupation licence and not to the subsequent lease. Yet some may more will be required under the lease. It however appears from the Governor's despatch, in which he says that if his proposal for an immediate lease is approved some expenditure within the first five years, in addition to the Committee's stipulations for the first three years, will be necessary at a later point, and that it must be a condition of the lease, binding on every transferee, to maintain the permanent improvements on the scale laid down in foot over.
