I have the homeur to income you that I have made further equalities into the solds made on the Subbes by Abgretistan subjects and have elicited the following Additionation from Subbra, who were present when the paid a took places:

In all, three raids were unde. The first near Emlatchs was carried out by 8 Sulabba bix of whom were armed with giftes and two carried spears. Three bonas of cattle - about 400 head - and three bonas of goats - about 1000 head - week looted. He people were killed. The headman of three Sulabba is one Sadi.

Two days taker the Cabbra at Malatcha were attacked by a considerable number of Gulabia some of whim carried rifles and come spears. Subject leases on this occasion ward? Then and a worsh killed and? beams of cattle - about 800 head - and 12 beams of sheep - about 6000 head - were segreted off by the Gulabba. In both the above raids the Cabbra raided were part of those who had run away from Abyselnian ferritory. About three weaks of a mouth after the above svents the Sabbra at Malkona were attacked as the sarky hours of the morning by a force of about 30 objectations armed with rifles and a large number of Sulabba some of whom carried sifles, some spears and others attacks. On this occasion the Cabbra attacked were Duddy Maritcha's people

people and British subjects.

The Gabbra losses were 13 wemen, 4 children and 6 men killed and a large number of sheep and gents losted.

I put it to the witnesses that in this raid they had probably mistaken Galabba wid were wearing Abyesimian elethes for Abyesimians. They all asserted that they had made at error and gave the following reasons:-

- 1. That they all know abyssinians when they see them and that the features of the Gulabba and .

 Abyssinians are absolutely different.
- 2. That the Abyssinians stopped the Gulabba from any further massacre of women and children.
- 3. That the Abyssinians talked Abyssinian and some of them Boran and the Gulabba did not.
- 4. That the Gulabba were pieces of iron or other metal stuck through the lower lip.
- 5. That the party of Abyssinians kept to themselves and did not work. All the work such as herding, malking stock and gathering firemped being done by the Gulabba.
- 6. That the Abyssinians would not drink camels milk and the Gulabba drank it.

From the statements made by the Gabbra I regret to say there seems no longer any doubt that Abysainians were the ringicaders of the Maikena raid, but I doubt if as many as 30 Abysainians took part in it.
