With reference to my telegram of the 24th of June I have the honour to submit the name of Dr W.G. Prichard, L.R.C.S., L.R.C.P., (Edin.) L.F.P. (Glas.), for promotion to the vacant post of Senior Medical Officer in this Protectorate.

2. Dr Prichard was appointed Medical Officer in the East Africa and Uganda Protectorates on the 24th of August, 1903, and has therefore completed over ten years service, during which he has been employed in East Africa, Uganda, and in Somaliland as Deputy Principal Medical Officer during the campaign of 1909.

3. The Principal Medical Officer reports that he is a reliable and conscientious officer who has performed his duties with zeal and discretion. He possesses a fund of common sense and disciplinary powers, and is at present filling the post of Acting Deputy Principal Medical Officer during the absence of Dr Haran on leave.

4. Dr Prichard accompanied me on my recent tour through the Masai Reserve, and my personal opinion

opinion of him is such that I can confidently endorse Dr Milne's recommendation.

5. I am unable to submit the name of Dr C.L. Chevallier for the vacancy for the reasons which I stated in my Confidential despatch No. 134 of the 16th of December. I am of opinion that it would be inadvisable to promote him to the vacancy.

6. If my proposal meets with your approval I recommend that the appointment date from the 1st of April last when the vacancy was created by the promotion of Dr Radford to the post of Chief Sanitation Officer.
