Unanimous resolution passed by the Monbasa Chamber of Commerce at a meeting held in Monbasa on 24th March 1915.

This Chamber has considered the harbour scheme placed before it, and explained by Mr. Blake-Taylor, and Mr. Maurice Wilson, and desires to record its emphatic approval of the general principles of the same, and pledges itself to continue its active support until the scheme has been brought to completion.

The Chamber further begs to thank Mr. Blake-Taylor and Mr. Maurice Wilson, for their efforts in furthering the trade and commerce of this country, and welcomes the opportunity of thanking the Imperial Government for its business-like fore-thought in sending out an Engineer of Mr. Maurice Wilson's ability, to report and advise on the requirements of the Port, and trusts that the money required for at least the first section of the scheme may be provided with the least possible delay; for which section the demand is urgent and imperative, and would further urge, that, financial provision be considered in reference to the second section, to be proceeded with immediately on completion of the first.
