Sir,

In reply to your despatch No. 842 of the 3rd of October, I have the honour to inform you that Dr. Heard, who was District Surgeon at Eldoret until the end of last month, has resigned his appointment and that at present there is, therefore, no Chemist or Government Medical Officer at that place.

2. It has not yet been possible to obtain the services of another local practitioner in place of Dr. Heard and as it may be difficult to fill the appointment of District Surgeon I have thought it advisable to include provision for a Government Medical Officer for Eldoret in the draft Estimates for the coming financial year, although I am not yet in a position to decide definitely whether the appointment will be justified.

3. I would add that it is the practice in out-stations to allow private individuals the privilege of purchasing drugs and having their prescriptions
