however, that it may be possible to avoid this course, owing to the fact that all the metal sent in has been melted into bars, and that to that extent, therefore, the coinage is in progress. This being the case, it would be necessary to fix a price to be paid for the work of melting the bars, and the amount to be paid for piecework to workmen in the Operative Department. These rates could no doubt be fixed on an equitable basis, subject to the sanction of the Treasury, but the matter is rather a complicated one, and if the supply of further coin can be postponed until next year any difficulty in connection with the transfer of the work at its present stage would be avoided.

The Deputy Master very much regrets that it has not been found possible hitherto to make further progress with the execution of the order, but the pressure which has arisen on the resources of the Mint in every direction has been very considerable and could not well have been foreseen when the order was issued.
