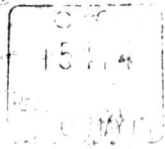

Your Excellency:-

I lost no time in communicating to the Secretary of State for the Colonies the Note respecting the claim of the German subject, Herr Emil Toet against His Majesty's Government which Your Excellency was good enough to address to me on April 16th, and I now have the honour to inform you that the matter has been referred to the Governor of British East Africa, whose observations have not yet been received.

In the event of no reply being received by the next mail from British East Africa the attention of the Governor will be invited to the matter by telegraph. I hope therefore shortly to be in a position to furnish Your Excellency with a reply to your Note of June 14th last.
