I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Read's letter of the 10th ultimo (3887/1913), further respecting the question of the House Allowance to be granted to European subordinate officials in the East African Protectorate.

In reply I am to request you to inform Mr. Secretary Harcourt that in the circumstances represented My Lords sanction the proposal that the £40 rate should be approved for all Clerks and other European subordinates who may be required to rent quarters, regardless of where they may be stationed.
