Sir,

I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Read's letter of the 6th instant (5896/1912)* further respecting the proposal that the anticipated expenditure by the East Africa Protectorate of £14,000 on the Uganda Railway in the ensuing financial year should be met by the provision in the Colonial Services Estimate 1912/14 of a Grant in Aid of that amount.

In reply I am to state that my Lords have given their most careful consideration to the further arguments adduced by Mr. Secretary Harcourt but upon a review of all the circumstances of the case they regret to be unable to modify the decision communicated to you in my letter of the 18th ultimo.
