In the circumstances represented by Mr. Secretary
Harcourt in Mr. Head's letter of the 4th instant (10686/1913)
the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury sanction

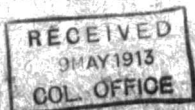
