Sir,

I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Sir E. Just's letter of the 30th ultimo (13369/1913), further respecting the re-drafting of Rules Nos. 2 and 3 for regulating the allocation of expenditure between the Capital and Revenue Accounts of the Uganda Railway, in order to meet the altered conditions resulting from the establishment of an Insurance and Depreciation Fund for the Uganda Railway steamers.

My Lords are glad to learn that Mr. Secretary Harcourt is willing to charge to Railway special expenditure all supplementary expenditure required to make good deficiencies in the Insurance and Depreciation fund, and subject to modification in this respect they now assent to the amendment of Rules 2 and 3 as proposed in Mr. Read's letter of the 27th March last (5474/1913).
