Sir,

I have laid before the Lord Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Boodle's letter of the 10th instant (14004/1913) and its enclosures respecting the estimated cost of proposed measures for the suppression of rinderpest in the East African Protectorate.

In reply I am to request you to inform Mr. Secretary Harcourt that in the circumstances proposed I should approve an expenditure by the Government of the East African Protectorate of £1,050 for Steam and Electrical Power and the Installation of Gas at the Laboratory at Nairobi, on condition that the cost will be met from savings on the authorised expenditure of the Protectorate for the current financial year.
