I have laid before the Lord Commissioners of His  
Majesty's Treasury Mr. Eddie letter of the 10th instant  
114064/1915, and its enclosures relating to the estimated  
cost of proposed measures for the prevention of rinderpest  
in the East African Protectorate.

In reply I am requested you inform Mr. Secretary  
Harcourt that in the circumstances you  
approve an expenditure by the Government of the East African  
Protectorate of £1,000 for Steam and Electrical power and  
the Installation of Gas at the Laboratory at Nairobi, on  
condition that the cost will be met from savings on the  
authorised expenditure of the Protectorate for the current  
financial year.
