I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Read's letter of the 21st ultimo (1481/1913) and his accompanying Quarterly Returns of expenditure incurred by the Government of the East Africa Protectorate, provision for which was not made on the Estimates for the year, during the periods 1st July to 31st September and 1st October to 31st December 1912.
