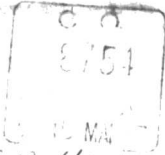

Dear Sir J. Anderson

I have discussed this with Mr. Risley and Mr. Cunningham. We have 4 good men who are ready to go but Mr. Sheridan seems to have done very well to receive a refusal. In the view I think he might be offered the post and if he accepts it, the vacancy so created in Nyasaland might be given to the P.S. to fill.

The scale at which Mr. Sheridan now holds the appointment 250-15-400 £ is a very low one to offer to a good legal candidate but I think that if it could be somewhat improved - say to start at 300 £ that we might be able to secure Mr. Ollivant - (see below) who I think would do very well indeed.

If it is decided to offer the post to Mr. Sheridan, suppose it could be an answer by telegram could be asked for, in order that we may inform the candidates we have sounded & then see if they will stand for Mr. Sheridan's present post? Mr. Cunningham agrees. 18/11/13
