With reference to your letter of the 14th of August 27361/1913 relative to the appointment of an Assistant in the Postal and Telegraph Department of the East Africa and Uganda Protectorates, I am directed by the Postmaster General to acquaint you for the information of the Secretary of State for the Colonies that he can recommend for the appointment Mr. T.
