Sir,

In Clause 42 of the Contract dated 13th
April 1911 for the construction, maintenance and
working of a railway to Lake Magadi in the East
Africa Protectorate as a branch of the Uganda Railway the provisions have been set out which shall have
effect with respect to the traffic of our Company
over the whole line of reilway between the Contractors' works and the Contractors' port, and, amongst
other items, the rate of freight to be paid by the
Company per ton mile on coal (which expression includes
liquid fuel) is dealt with.

In view of the construction of the Company's port works having been unfortunately sonsiderably delayed, it may not be possible to have same ready to receive bulk oil when this will be needed for running the plant at Magadi, and we should, therefore, like to arrange with the Asiatic Petroleum Co. Ltd. to use Messrs Smith Mackenzie's tank installation at Kilindini for storing and supplying fuel to us. Before, however, being able to so we ought to know if the Uganda Railway administration would be willing to accept the

same rate per ten mile on fuel from Messre Smith Mackenzie's installation to Magadi as her been granted to us for the transport of fuel from our port to our works at Magadi.

- 3. As the Asiatic Petroleum Co. inform us that they would not be able to discuss this question with us, unless a decinion can be arrived at before the end of this month, we should feel very much obliged if you would be good enough to communicate by cable at our expense with the Administration of the Uganda Rail-way.
- 4. May we suggest that this opportunity should also be used to ascertain definitely if the Government of the Protectorate has any intention of alienating from us any of the land which has been granted us for the purpose of the erection of our port works. We have taken an opportunity of explaining personally to Mr Read that it does not seem possible to us to shift our works, now that all arrangements for their erection on this land have been made, and the matter is of such vital importance to us that we will cladly incur the expense of cable communication to have this question settled without delay.

Extracts from a letter received by Messes Livesey Son

& Henderson from our Resident Empineer C.
Dated 11th March 1913.

The Manager wired to say he wished to see me on the 5th inst on his way up from the Port and I travelled up to Mairobi in his coach.

Wilson, the new Government Dock Engineer and wife were also on beard. The Hanager showed me the new wharves scheme, This is an extraordinarily extensive affair, and though they have to look forward in designing this for large extensions, much of it cannot be carried out for lack of funds for many years to come.

To provide, however, for the extended wharves scheme, he Taylor mays they will have to cut away our cliff face for about 250 feet back to enable them to fill in behind the wharves on the Donga or valley to East of our site.

He asks me, therefore, to move our site 300 feet back from the cliff face. He states that while this work will not likely be taken in hand for perhaps 5 or 10 years, it would be very unwise to place or crect permanent buildings on this 300 feet, but we will have the use of the ground meantime for gardens or anything also we like. He constantly said there is no use whatever in building an approach to our proposed pier jetty, and that there was nothing in the contract as far as he could see that necessitated our carrying out this work. He said the docks will eventually join on to the extended end of our pier and all landing of material required by us can be eventually done expeditiously from the Government adjoining wheres. He

iscided also to ask us to change the alignment of our upper A level line so that it will better fit the scheme of challing yard he proposes to have at the back of our site

The low level line therefore probably not being required. I have ordered any sub-centracters on earthworks to be stopped on the branch lines and the reck sub-centracter in getting out rock for our approach neck to pier. Nothing yet has been put on paper by the Manager. He said he would hasten to do so, but up to now I have not heard from him.

The Manager says he has a Mr Atchison now working on the survey of the ground behind our high level site that is between it and the Uganda Railway and as soon as it is finished he will design the yard and so enable me to fix our line to theirs.

I pointed out to him while we were granted 14 acres to date we have 11 further acres ear marked for our use should an extension of our operations necessitate our requiring the additional land. He said "Right I will arrange that you will have the same acreage reserved: All I want is to move your whole present area back 300 feet."
