write to say that I am
quite willing, under the

circumstances that the
 memorial erected at
 Kismayu in the East
 Africa Protectorate to viz
 Lord Arthur Jenner, should
 be removed & re-erected
 in the central square of
 the town, provided that
 it will in that position
 fulfill its purpose of
 receiving rain water for

the use of the cattle of
 the natives, & that it will
 be accessible to the natives
 when they drive their
 cattle into the town.
 As to the place for the
 marble tablet, I am
 anxious that it should be
 in a position which will
 permit of the Arabic
 as well as the English

inscription being easily
read.
