Dear Sir,

Respecting the interview that I had with you in the early part of the year respecting the Uganda Railway. Our Manager in Mombasa writes to say that as far as the godowns at Kilindini are concerned, the Government have got no further in the matter. As I explained to you, the pier that you are constructing at Kilindini will be no use unless the traders have godown accommodation, and we cannot have this unless we can obtain suitable sites. When we have got the land, the godowns will require to be built, which will take some time, as there is a great shortage of not only warehouse accommodation, but also of dwelling houses. If you can do anything to speed up the authorities at Kilindini on this question, I shall be extremely obliged.
