Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the third paragraph of my despatch No. 243 of the 8th of April and to inform you that the Acting Provincial Commissioner, Nyanza, has reported that about 1,500 loads of maize have been harvested from plantations in connection with the Kisii afforestation scheme, and that it is anticipated that an approximate amount of Rs. 1,875 will be realised on account of the sale.

2. I have sanctioned this amount, which should be adequate to meet the cost of all labour employed, being placed to the credit of the scheme. The sum should also be sufficient to defray expenses in connection with the Agricultural Instructor and should also admit of the undertaking of more extensive operations with regard to the afforestation of the South Kavirondo District.

3. I trust that I may receive in due course an expression of your approval of my action.
