Your despatch of 2nd February of 1911 owing
to vacancies the whole of northern frontier districts
in charge of Indian Native Surgeon. Further troops
shortly proceeding to this District Medical position
very serious. If there is any as you say difficulty
of obtaining candidates owing to uncertainty as to
future would suggest making this definite clear candidates
for two existing vacancies that their appointments
would be made permanent after three years' period if
satisfactory.
