Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the final paragraph of the letter from the Lords Commissioners of the Treasury dated the 11th of September, enclosed in your Confidential despatch of the 8th of October.

2. I am of opinion that there would not appear to be any necessity for the modification of the Rules of the Uganda Railway Provident Fund in consequence of the new arrangements for the administration of the Busoga Railway. All the necessary charges to support the Fund are included in the working expenses of either the Busoga Railway, or of the Uganda Railway Marine and their inclusion in the accounts of the Uganda Railway Provident Fund would seem to be a simple and effective arrangement.

3. I would add that the Governor of Uganda concurs in these views.
