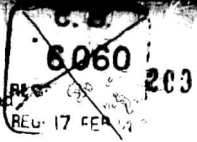

The Deputy Governor of the East Africa Protectorate to the Secretary of State for the Colonies.

No. 37 16th February. Graham reports from Serenli that

numbers armament and spirit of enemy's force have been hitherto hopelessly under-estimated and requests immediate despatch of three Uganda Companies and one company of 1st Battalion King's African Rifles from Nairobi. Am arranging for this and I am asking Zanzibar to send one company Nairobi as this part of Protectorate will be depleted of troops. Gravity of situation here has increased by fact that Graham unable to effect junction with force 200 King's African Rifles at Garrebahare, 75 miles to the north of Serenli. This force entirely cut off and has no transport, but has food supplies till 15th day and can entrench, holding strong position. Have consulted Colonel Ward and I recommend that, owing to difficulty in obtaining camel transport in Jubaland, transport camel corps, 300 camels with establishment of attendants, should be sent at once from India Kismayu. Graham asks that three Army Service Corps Officers from England or India trust they will be despatched as soon as possible. Owing to urgent necessity for mounted troops and difficulty in obtaining mounts locally Ward strongly recommends one company Camel Corps be obtained from Sudan or, failing that, Somaliland. I have authorised Ward to engage ex 6th Battalion King's African Rifles Somalis as illaloes. Sanction requested

to raise one company ex soldiers for duty locally. Inspector General, King's African Rifles, in vicinity of Ajheir, am recalling him to advise on military situation. Governor on tour north Kavirondo and returns February 25th. Admiral, Cape Station, leaving cruiser East African waters.
