His Majesty's Secretary of State having had occasion to communicate with the Government of this Protectorate regarding the question of Medical Certificates of Officers proceeding on leave, I have to invite your attention to the instructions set forth for guidance in Departmental Circular and enclosure No. 156, dated the 13th June 1913.
