Reports return to Nairobi 26th February. Is satisfied that everything has been done to send full information, that action which has been taken is correct and that that which is proposed is desirable. States as to movements of "Pegasus". Quoted telegram from Colonel Graham as to progress of operations. Is of opinion that situation probably not so serious as previously anticipated. Is sending to Berbera for 30 ponies for use of Illaloos.

Telegram from the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate to the Secretary of State for the Colonies.

No. 59. February 26th. Returned Nairobi this morning. Have immediately and very carefully perused all correspondence on subject of Marenan expedition which has taken place since my departure from Kisumu. I am satisfied that every effort has been made to keep you fully and punctually informed as to development. I could have done no more had I been here. Allowance must be made for distance between head quarters and seat of operations for consequent delay in receipt of communications and mutilation of telegraphic report. I have now held conference, present Chief Secretary, Colonel Ward, Commander Pegasus, Provincial Commissioner, Jubaland Officer in charge of troops, Nairobi. After hearing them I am satisfied that action which has been taken is correct and that that which is proposed is desirable. Pegasus leaves for Kismayu Sunday with units supplementary to reinforcements already despatched and will remain ~~on Tana~~ <sup>(2) Tana</sup> on Tana coast to afford assistance in communication by wireless telegraphy. Following telegram has been received Ceremli to say ~~begin~~

February 22nd. Following received from Colonel Ward dated February 20th: Arrived at Farnwen yesterday without opposition. Arrangements have been made for our Somali section armed sycos and Aulihan Illaloes to leave camp by night with a view to rounding up Tilha stock. Small skirmish between Illaloes and Tilha enemy's casualties five killed our casualties Illaloes killed and wounded two. Result though disappointing has I consider definitely committed Aulihan to our side. Proceeding to Gerbahare via Famwen Dur and Jehnadin February 21st. Ceremonial report signallers ambuscaded resulting in killed and wounded two. Have made reconnaissance as far as Abumidirt but saw nothing. ~~Telegram ends~~ We are of opinion that position probably not so serious as anticipated from previous reports. On recommendation of Colonel Ward I am sending telegram to Berbera to supply thirty ponies if possible for use of Illaloes.


