Sir,

I have the honour to refer to your despatch No. 179 of the 2nd of April 1912 respecting the procedure to be followed with regard to unforeseen expenditure and to inform you that I have provisionally authorized the opening of a separate sub-head for such expenditure as cannot be charged to existing votes in connection with the operations against the Marenan tribe.

2. I have accordingly signed a Special Warrant for £1,000 to cover any expenditure which may be incurred this year chargeable against Vote 18A Military Special Expenditure, Sub-head "Expenses of extra troops and transport on Marenan Patrol" and I trust that it will be possible to meet this amount from savings.

3. I propose to submit further suggestions to provide for the expenditure during next financial year when I am in a position to gauge with greater accuracy the sum which is likely to be required.

4. I hope that I may receive in due course an expression of your approval of this arrangement.

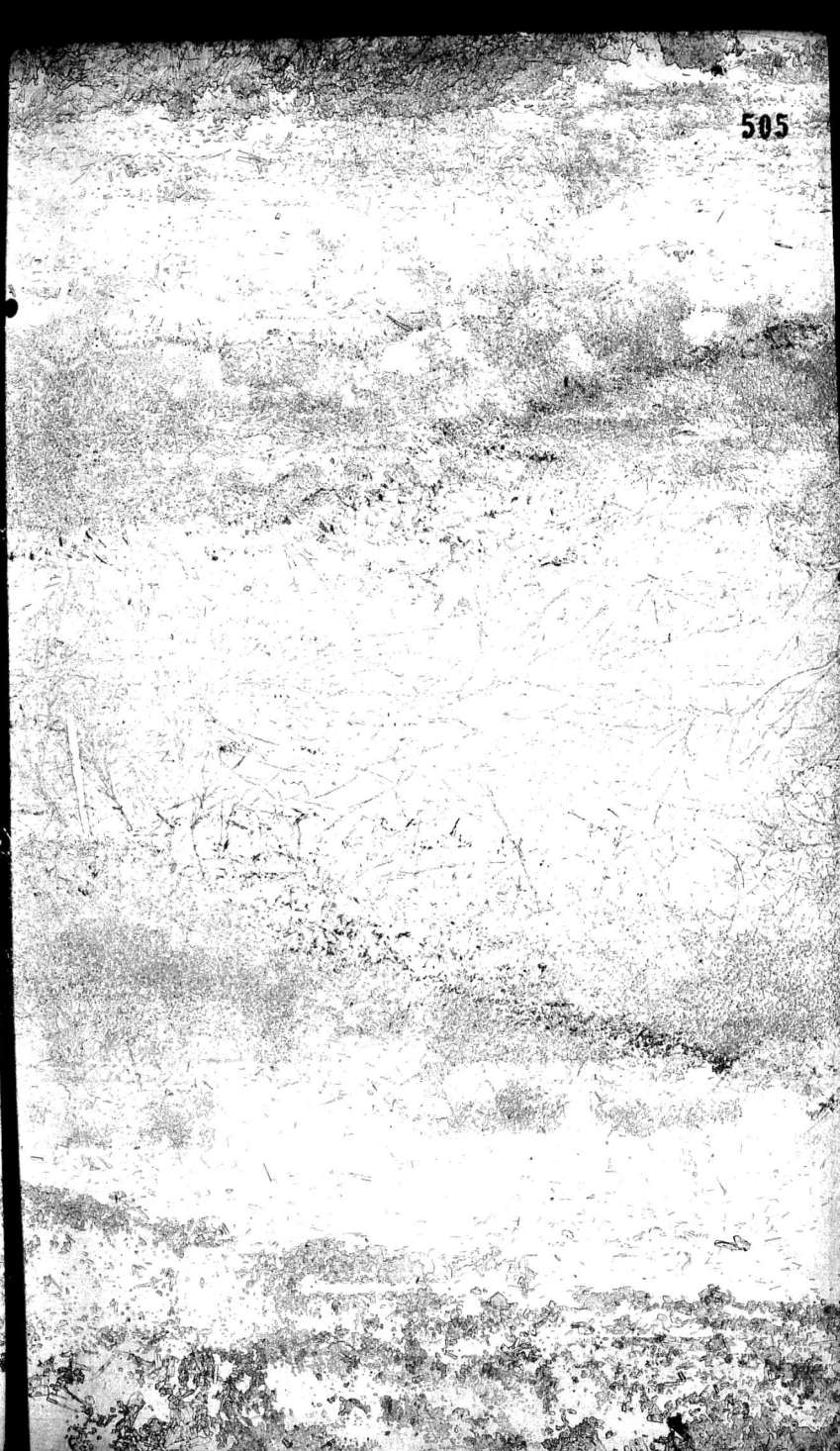
