No. 100 ? Your despatch of 19th December No. 1000 most
essential that telegraphic communication with Jubaland
should be maintained. At present this is being done
with assistance from His Majesty the King Royal Navy
and their wireless installation but Admiral most
anxious that his ships should be relieved of these
duties. When may London wireless installation be
expected to arrive at Mombasa if there will be any
delay in arrival consider very desirable that field
wireless apparatus capable operating 200 miles so as
to connect Giumbo with Lamu should be sent out. If
necessary halfway station would be established in
which case 2 sets of apparatus each capable of covering
120 miles would be required.


