No. 211 June 26th Your despatch of 26th May Confidential am advised that not desirable on technical grounds for this Government to bring action for declaration title to land which formed subject of correspondence ^{work} is not clear ^{who} should be defendants. Consider best course to pursue would be apply land titles ordinance 1908 to the area in dispute. Due notice of its application should be given to the authorities of the Government of Germany in order that claimants may have sufficient intimation of the time within which their claims should be lodged. Under ordinance all claims can be considered.
