With reference to my despatch No. 894 of December 27th 1912, I have the honour to inform you that I have lately had under consideration the question of revising the list of native languages for which bonuses are granted.

- 2. The present list which was forwarded under cover of Sir F. Jackson's despatch No. 400 of July 21st, 1909, contains the dialects of smaller tribes with whom officers are not likely to be brought into constant contact, and I consider that it is preferable that only the more important languages should be studied.
 - 3. I have therefore caused a circular letter to be issued to the effect that bonuses in future will only be granted for the following languages:
