Sir,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your Circular despatch of the 20th of May, and to inform you that I cordially concur in the proposal that the official Entomologists of the Empire should meet in London next July. I am of opinion that great benefit is likely to accrue to this Protectorate thereby.

2. The Government Entomologist, Mr. T. J. Anderson, is due to proceed on leave in May and is desirous of attending the Conference. I regret, however, that the Mycologist will be unable to accompany him.

3. Mr. Anderson has submitted a further subject for discussion, viz: "The distribution of parasites of Insect pests; the dissemination of information as to places where such parasites are obtainable, and what attention is necessary during transit on ships".
