Sir,

I have the honour to report that subject to your approval I have sanctioned the appointment of Mr. H. E. Evans to assist Mr. Parkinson in the water reconnaissance, Northern Frontier District.

2. Mr. Evans has just arrived from South Africa where he obtained the diploma of Theoretical Surveying at the Cape University and the degree of B.A. He has moreover two years field experience of surveying in this Protectorate, can speak Swahili and is accustomed to handling natives.

3. I therefore considered that he would be very useful to Mr. Parkinson and would take the place of the foreman of works whom it was proposed
