With reference to the Foreign Office letter of the 17th ultimo, relative to the proposed appointment of a Consul for Southern Abyssinia, I am directed by Secretary Sir Edward Grey to inform you that Mr. Thesiger has been consulted in the matter and is of the opinion that Mega would appear to be the most suitable place of residence for a Consul in Southern Abyssinia.

Sir Edward Grey understands that the grounds upon which Mr. Thesiger bases his recommendation are the accessibility of lega to the various frontier posts, and its growing political and commercial importance.
