

Monsieur le Secrétaire d'Etat,

A la demande de Monsieur le Ministre des Colonies j'ai l'honneur de recourir aux bons offices de Votre Excellence à l'effet d'obtenir que le Gouvernement de Sa Majesté Britannique envoie des instructions télégraphiques prescrivant aux autorités de l'Afrique orientale anglaise et de l'Ouganda de se mettre en rapport avec les autorités belges du Congo afin d'assurer le cheminement vers la frontière de marchandises destinées à Kilo (Ituri)

Ces marchandises sont restées en souffrance à Mombassa ou sur la route entre ce port et la frontière belge. Leur transport avait été confié à l'Agence allemande Hansing dont les opérations paraissent avoir été suspendues par ordre des autorités coloniales britanniques.
