I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your despatch No.450 of August 16th informing me that you have selected Mr.C.C.Bowring, C.M.G., Treasurer, for the appointment of Chief Secretary to the Government of this Protectorate. I observe also that the appointment is to date from April 1st last and that you have authorized the Crown Aments to pay to Mr.Bewring the arrears of salary due to him from that date and also duty pay for the period from 1st April to April 24th inclusive.

2. I have hitherto made no proposals with regard to the appointment of an Acting Chief Secretary as in your telegram of May P2nd you intermed me that Mr.Bowring's appointment would not take effect until after the expiration of his leave. Since however this appointment is to date from 1st April, I propose with your concurrence to appoint Mr.A.C.Hollie, C.M.G., Secretary for Native Affeirs, to be Acting Chief, Secretary from May P2nd, the day on which Mr.Monson left for England and Mr.Hellie assumed entire control of the Contro
