COPY TELEGRAM FROM SECRETARY OF STATE TO VICEROY,  
ARMY DEPARTMENT, DATED 23RD OCTOBER 1914.

No. 1282. It is necessary for me to be  
kept fully and promptly informed as regards Expedition  
B so that I may when necessary consult with Admiralty  
and Colonial Office. Please therefore instruct  
Aitken to report to me direct all matters regarding  
progress of expedition including actions, casualties  
and operations. All questions of policy and operations  
beyond those already indicated must be referred by  
Aitken to me for instructions. All such telegrams  
should be repeated to you. Please also repeat any  
telegrams you may send direct to Aitken here.  
Corresponding action will be taken by me.
