I have the honour to invite your attention to paragraph 11 of the Regulations in pursuance of the East Africa and Uganda (Currency) Order of Council of the 10th of February 1900, in which it is laid down that the Currency Notes shall be authenticated by a facsimile of the signature of the Treasurer of the East Africa Protectorate for the time being.

All notes now in stock bear Mr. Bowring's signature and are dated the 1st of September 1900. But as Mr. Bowring has now ceased to be Treasurer I presume that, under the regulation referred to above, any new issues of notes should bear a different date and be authenticated by the signature of Mr. Smallwood, the present Treasurer.
