I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Fiddes's letter of the 6th instant (39993/1910) and the enclosed copy of a telegram from the Officer Administering the Government of the East Africa Protectorate relating to Railway Special Expenditure for the year 1911-12, and I am to state that in the special circumstances of the case My Lords concur in the terms of the reply which Mr. Secretary Harcourt proposes to send thereto, on the understanding that the result will not be to prejudice in any way the questions connected with the Estimates for the coming year which still remain to be discussed, or to increase the total expenditure for that year beyond the amount justified under the "half and half principle".
